London by the Underground

shows you how to go to more than 50 points of interest easily and inexpensively by using London's excellent Underground system, also known as "the Tube". The official map of the London Underground is shown on the other side of this guide.

How to Go to Points of Interest


on the right shows exactly how to walk to these points from the nearest Underground stations. Use the Underground lines and stations indicated.

Maps of points of interest on the right show streets, landmarks and Underground stations and are oriented to enable you to easily walk to points of interest. Since some stations may have multiple exits to choose from, some re-orientation to the maps may be necessary at exits.


The Underground





Buy tickets from self-service machines or ticket offices. Fares are based on zones. Buy a *One Day Travelcard* for two, four or all six zones. The Travelcard is good for unlimited off-peak travel after 0930 weekdays and all day weekends by Tube, Bus or Train throughout the zones selected. A seven day card is available (passport photo required).


The Underground is open 0530 to 0030 M-Sa and 0730 to 2330 Su. Insert ticket into gate and retain for onward travel and exit. Each Underground line is named and color-coded. Choose the line and be sure to go to the correct platform for the direction you want to go. Avoid rush hours, late night travel and empty cars. As in all big cities, be alert for pickpockets and keep valuables in a safe, hidden place.

- 5 Madame Tussaud's** Marylebone Rd. ☎ 0171-935 6861. Wax images of infamous people. The Spirit of London ride. **\$**
- 6 London Planetarium** Marylebone Rd. ☎ 0171-935 6861. High tech shows. **\$**
- 7 Chiswick House** Burlington Lane. ☎ 0181-995 0508. Restored villa. Magnificent interior & ornate gardens. **\$**
- 8 Hogarth's House** Hogarth Lane. ☎ 0181-994 6757. Restored former house & works of artist, William Hogarth. ⌚ *Tu*
- 9 Kew Gardens** Kew Road, Richmond. ☎ 0181-940 1171. 300 acres of 50,000+ species. Conservatory with 10 habitats. **\$** Also **Kew Palace** ☎ 0181-940 3321. One of the Historic Royal Palaces. **\$**
- 10 Kensington Palace & Gardens** Kensington Gardens. ☎ 0171-937 9561. One of the Historic Royal Palaces. State Apartments & Court Dress Collection. Decorations, paintings, furniture & beautiful gardens. Statue of Peter Pan in greater park area. **\$**
- 11 Serpentine Gallery** Kensington Gardens. ☎ 0171-402 6075. International exhibitions of contemporary art.
- 12 Selfridges** 400 Oxford St. One of London's largest & most famous dept stores. Tourist info.
- 13 Wallace Collection** Hertford House, Manchester Sq. ☎ 0171-935 0687. British & European paintings, furniture, porcelain & weaponry.
- 14 London Zoo** Regent's Park. ☎ 0171-482 2660. Animals, birds, reptiles, insects, large aquarium, special exhibits. **\$**
- 15 Highgate Cemetery** Swain's Lane. ☎ 0181-340 1834. Burial place of Karl Marx & other famous people. West side (*tours only*). **\$**
- 16 Victoria & Albert Museum** Cromwell Rd. ☎ 0171-938 8441. Decorative arts incl sculpture, ceramics, glass, furniture, woodwork, textiles, dress, silver & jewelry. European costume & fashion. Frank Lloyd Wright. **\$** (*donation*)
- 17 Natural History Museum** Cromwell Rd. ☎ 0171-938 9123. Life & earth galleries. Human biology, dinosaurs, creepy crawlies & hands-on discovery center. **\$**
- 18 Science Museum** Exhibition Rd. ☎ 0171-938 8000. The progress of science & technology thru the ages. Discoveries & inventions. Hands-on displays. **\$**
- 19 Harrods** Brompton Rd. Perhaps the most famous store in the world. London's elegant dept store.
- 20 Hyde Park** London's largest park. Speakers' Corner where orators are assured an audience! (*Su*)
- 21 Apsley House** (Wellington Museum), Hyde Park Corner. ☎ 0171-499 5676. Branch of Victoria & Albert Museum. Magnificent refurbished mansion. Paintings, porcelain, silver, sculpture & furniture. ⌚ *M* **\$**
- 22 National Army Museum** Royal Hospital Rd. ☎ 0171-730 0717. The personal side of war—the story of the British soldier. Weapons, uniforms, medals, photos & portraits.
- 23 Buckingham Palace** The Mall. ☎ 0171-493 3175. London home of the Queen. Tours (*Aug & Sept*) **\$**. Changing of the Guard, 1130. Also **The Queen's Gallery** Works of art from the Royal Collection. ⌚ *M* **\$**; **The Royal Mews** State carriages, coaches, horses, equipage. **\$** ☎ 0171-799 2331 (*Gallery & Mews*). Tourist info. (Victoria Station).
- 24 Houses of Parliament/Big Ben** Parliament Sq. Seat of British Govt. House of Lords & House of Commons. Big Ben, world famous clock & bell tower. Can only be viewed from outside.
- 25 Westminster Abbey** Parliament Sq. ☎ 0171-222 7110. British royalty crowned & buried here along with other famous statesmen, musicians & poets. Brass rubbings. Tours available. **\$** (*attractions*)
- 26 Piccadilly Circus** Central hub of London daily life. Statue of Eros. Many worthwhile attractions nearby. People watching! Tourist info.
- 27 Museum of Mankind** 6 Burlington Gardens. ☎ 0171-323 8043. Ethnology dept of the British Museum. Artifacts, carvings & weapons from the non-Western world.
- 28 Royal Academy of Arts** Burlington House, Piccadilly. ☎ 0171-439 4996. Changing art exhibitions in one of Europe's most attractive galleries. **\$**

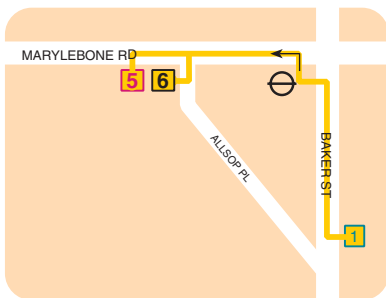

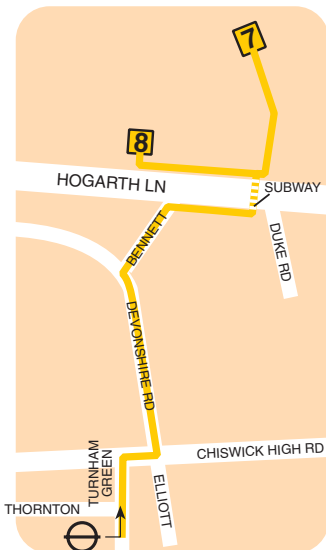
